Emergency Phone

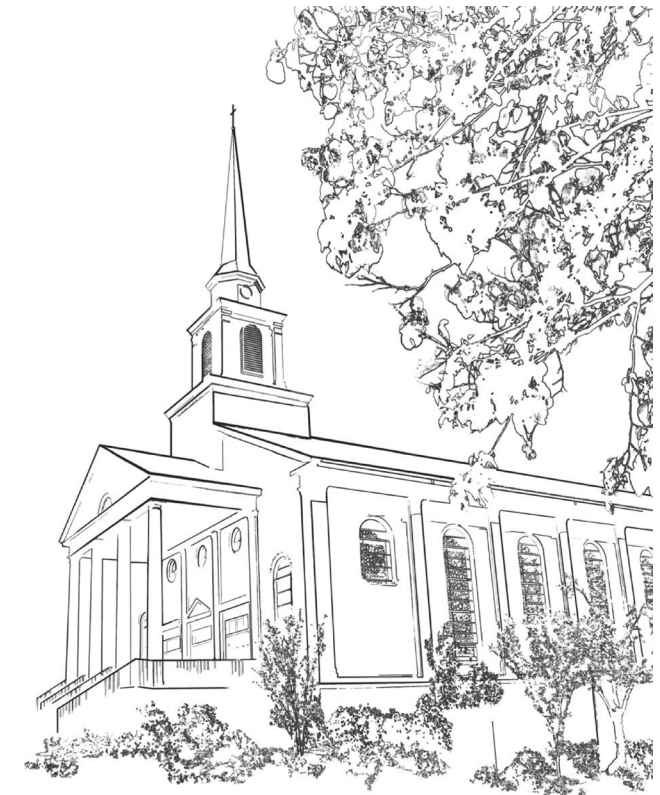
